STIPULATION

NOW ON this 17th day of October, 2006, the Examiner of the Commission on Judicial Qualifications and Respondent reach the following agreed resolution of the pending Commission on Judicial Qualifications Docket # 962.

1. Respondent agrees to and does resign his judicial position effective January 8, 2007, and will submit his resignation to Hon. Michael Powers, Chief Judge of the 8th Judicial District.
2. Respondent agrees not to accept a position as or serve as a judge at any future time.
3. Respondent agrees to submit a letter of apology to the marriage participants involved in Count II, ¶2 of the Notice of Formal Proceedings.
4. Respondent has paid restitution to the Office of Judicial Administration in a determined amount.

5. Acceptance of this Stipulation stays this proceeding until January 9, 2007, when the proceeding will be terminated upon fulfillment of the Stipulation. Violation of this Stipulation constitutes a violation of the Canons of Judicial Conduct.
