Harris proposed moving the shared formula calculation on the worksheet, calculating the direct expense amount and adding it to the result of the shared formula • The committee ran several child support worksheets based on different scenarios to determine effect of proposal • The committee decided to send the current proposed revisions to the Supreme Court without any changes to the equal parenting time formula; the committee will ask the Supreme Court for permission to continue working on the formula in future meetings ○ Final language approval <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Committee reviewed revised language in guidelines to send to the Supreme Court for review • Appendices <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Committee approved final version of appendices to be included with proposed guideline revisions • Supplemental materials <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Committee tabled materials until after public comment period • Report to the Supreme Court <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A. Raymond discussed process to move guidelines through the public comment process; Supreme Court will review proposed revisions and approve whether or not the guidelines will be posted for public comment for 30 days; if approved, OJA will use survey monkey to collect public comments; after the public comment period, the committee will review the

	guidelines to determine if any additional revisions are necessary; the guidelines will then return to the Supreme Court for final approval
